2. Alfuzosin (Uroxatral)	Patient Instruction: Once Daily (0-1-0) Tablet After Food For 1 day Alfuzosin is a medication that comes in the form of an extended-release tablet. It treats benign prostatic hyperplasia and symptoms of an enlarged prostate.
3. Alfuzosin (Uroxatral)	Patient Instruction: Twice Daily (1-1-0) Tablet After Food For 1 day Alfuzosin is a medication that comes in the form of an extended-release tablet. It treats benign prostatic hyperplasia and symptoms of an enlarged prostate.
4. Tadalafil (Cialis)	Patient Instruction: Once Daily (0-0-1) Tablet After Food For 1 day Tadalafil (Cialis) is used to treat erectile dysfunction (ED, impotence; inability to get or keep an erection), and the symptoms of benign prostatic hyperplasia .

5. Ibuprofen (Advil)

Patient Instruction: Thrice Daily (1-1-1) Tablet After Food For 3 day
